Annual Meeting Scholarship Program Application

The North Carolina Mosquito and Vector Control Association (NCMVCA) Annual Meeting Scholarship program is available to full-time students pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree at any accredited North Carolina college or university. Recent graduates, within one year of completing their degree, are also eligible. The goal of this program is to promote greater student participation at the NCMVCA annual meeting and encourage scholarly mosquito control and vector biology research. Applicants must agree to give a 10-15 minute presentation at the annual meeting. Scholarships will be awarded annually to defray the costs of attending the annual meeting. The award will consist of meeting registration waiver plus \$250 towards the cost of room, food and travel. The number of annual scholarship awards will vary depending on available funding. The due date for this year's applications is November 15th 2019.
