GENERAL DEFINITION OF WORK:

Professional environmental health work in the promotion of public health through education, surveillance, consultation, inspection and enforcement of State, local and Federal environmental health laws and regulations. Employee must be authorized in on-site wastewater program. Primary responsibility will be with the Food & Lodging program however there may be some additional work responsibilities as a generalist in a variety of environmental health programs.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES, EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE:

Working knowledge of environmental health laws, rules, and procedures, as well as complete understanding of the concepts of public health law. Practical knowledge of microbiology, biology, chemistry, food science, epidemiology, soil science, entomology, and basic engineering technology as applied to environmental health practices. Working knowledge of the design of on-site waste water treatment systems, protection of water supplies, food sanitation, food borne diseases, communicable diseases, vector, control, solid waste management, and institutional sanitation. Ability to exercise sound judgment and deal tactfully with a wide range of public contacts while enforcing public health laws and regulations. Ability to plan and schedule work activities and perform assignments. Ability to apply environmental health knowledge and techniques in the investigation of environmental health problems. Ability to work with others in solving the more complex environmental problems.

MINIMUM EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

Graduation from a four-year college or university with 30 semester hours of course work in the physical and biological sciences and two years of exposure in environmental health. Registered as an environmental health specialist with the state of North Carolina. Will consider EHS trainee
