**Description of Work:** Promote public health through independent fieldwork in education, inspection, surveillance, and enforcement of environmental health programs such as food/lodging/institutions, on-site wastewater systems, water supplies and complaint investigations. The majority of the work will be in the on-site water protection section. This position will be assigned in Watauga County. Must have ability to work well with the public, possess a good understanding of environmental health rules and regulations, good oral and written communication skills and some computer user skills. Must be able to operate a motor vehicle and have an un-revoked NC driver's license.

Applicant must be in good physical health in order to perform field evaluations that are required to perform the duties of a Registered Environmental Health Specialist.

**Minimum Education and Training:** Must be a graduate of a four year college or university with 30 semester hours of course work in the physical or biological sciences and two years experience in environmental health; Or an environmental health degree and one year experience in environmental health; or an equivalent combination of training and experience.
