<u>Job Purpose:</u> To promote and protect public health and the environment through education, surveillance, inspection, consultation, and enforcement of local and state laws, rules, and regulations in accordance with proper policies and procedures

Responsibilities:

- Onsite Waste Water Quality Assurance Program Coordinator
 - o Reviews on-site wastewater permits and paperwork for completeness and accuracy;
 - o Prepares and presents quality assurance findings to staff when found during paperwork review;
 - Using QA findings recommends training needs to onsite waste water supervisor;
 - Acts as a consultant to other environmental health specialists, to contractors, and engineers both within and outside of the health department, and state agencies;
- Water Well Program Coordinator
 - o quality assurance review of all well permits that are issued by staff
 - o review of all water sample results and issuance of all water sample reports to the public
 - Lead person responsible for operating the downhole well camera and providing training to staff to use the downhole well camera
 - Assist in keeping the county's well regulations up to date
 - Supervise staff in the technical aspects of this program

Working under the Onsite Wastewater supervisor, this position coordinates the Onsite Well Water and Quality Assurance programs and as such requires extensive knowledge

in area of specialty. Ability to analyze and comprehend a wide variety of technical and administrative regulations, records, and reports. Ability to motivate and educate business and property owners and the consuming public in matters related to protecting and promoting public health. Must be able to periodically lift heavy objects, walk over rough terrain, and maneuver in close surroundings. Must be proficient in both written and oral communications. Ability to independently plan and schedule work activities and perform assignments. Ability to coordinate work in a specialized program. Ability to plan and implement education programs. Ability to work with others in solving the more complex environmental problems. Knowledge and ability to use personal computer in a Windows and Web Based Environment and experience with Geographic Information Systems and related software.
