New Hanover County is seeking an experienced Environmental Health Specialist to perform independent field work, current REHS is preferred. Duties may include FLI and/or OSWP field work, depending on service needs and priorities. Experience in either area of authorizations will be considered. Duties in Food Service include conducting risk-based inspections across the full array of establishments addressed by FLI. Duties in OSWP include review of and inspections related to on-site septic systems and wells, and inspections of complex "typed" septic systems. General priority duties include a commitment to excellent customer service; promotion and protection of public health through education, inspection, surveillance, and enforcement; investigation of complaints and reports; and other EHS duties assigned based on services needs and authorizations held.

Priority consideration will be given to those applicants meeting the minimum education and experience requirements for the position. Applicants meeting the required education and having only partial experience may be considered at a trainee rate of \$19.47 per hour.
