ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SPECIALIST (Food & Lodging)

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES: The primary duty of this position is to evaluate the sanitary conditions of restaurants, meat markets, schools, food stands, day care facilities, nursing homes, hospitals, residential care facilities, lodging establishments, public swimming pools, tattoo artists, and other establishments in accordance with the rules and regulations established by the Commission for Health Services.

Must have the ability to work well with the public, good understanding of environmental health rules and regulations, good oral and written communication skills and some computer user skills. Must be able to operate a motor vehicle and have a current NC driver's license.

MINIMUM EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE: Graduation from a four-year college or university with 30 semester of course work in the physical or biological sciences and two years of exposure in environmental health; or a four-year or Master's degree in environmental health from a program which is accredited by the National Accreditation Council for Environmental Health Curricula of the National Environmental Health Association and one year of experience in environmental health.

Preference may be given to applicants who are a currently Registered Environmental Health Specialist.
